



PROGRAM SNAPSHOT

THP+FC

Transitional Housing Placement Plus Foster Care (THP+FC) is a new placement option created through passage of the California Fostering Connections to Success Act. Like THP-Plus, THP+FC provides participants with safe, affordable housing and supportive services. Unlike THP-Plus, THP+FC is a Title IV-E reimbursable foster care placement where youth are provided court oversight and supervision by county child welfare or probation.

SCHOOL ENROLLMENT

51% of participants were not enrolled in school.

49% of participants were enrolled in school. Of those enrolled,

29% were completing their high school diploma or GED;

65% were attending a two-year college; &

6% were attending a four-year college.



HIGHEST EDUCATION ACHIEVED

21% of participants had completed some high school.

78% of participants had completed high school.

0% of participants had completed a certification or license at a community college.

0% of participants had completed their Associate's Degree.

0% of participants completed their Bachelor's Degree.



EMPLOYMENT

48% of participants were employed. Of those employed,

33% were full-time &

67% were part-time.

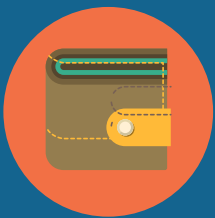
52% of participants were not employed. Of those not employed,

65% were seeking employment;

35% were not seeking employment; &

1% were determined unemployable,

SSI-eligible or other.

Average hourly wage of employed youth: **\$12.19**

Average monthly income from all sources: **\$1,061.60**

12% of participants were custodial parents

88% of participants were not custodial parents
