Each year, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development directs over \$500 million to California to address homelessness via 43 local Continuums of Care (CoCs). CoCs coordinate local providers working to combat homelessness, yet there is too often a disconnect between college students facing homelessness and access to services administered by these entities.
