It has been 10 years since John Burton Advocates for Youth and the California Coalition for Youth released the report *Too Big to Ignore: Youth Homelessness in California*. This important publication identified key barriers to reducing youth homelessness in California and proposed a multi-year state and federal policy agenda.

Of the policies identified, many have been achieved, yet the problem of homelessness among youth has worsened considerably, driven in larger part by the statewide housing affordability crisis and the continued lack of sustainable state funding.
